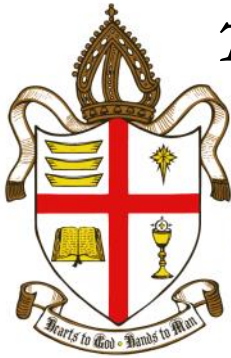

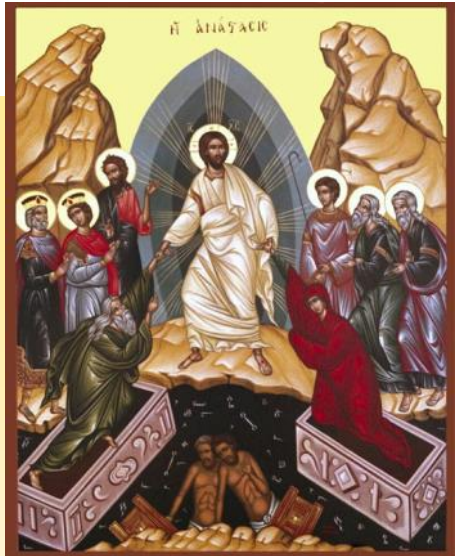

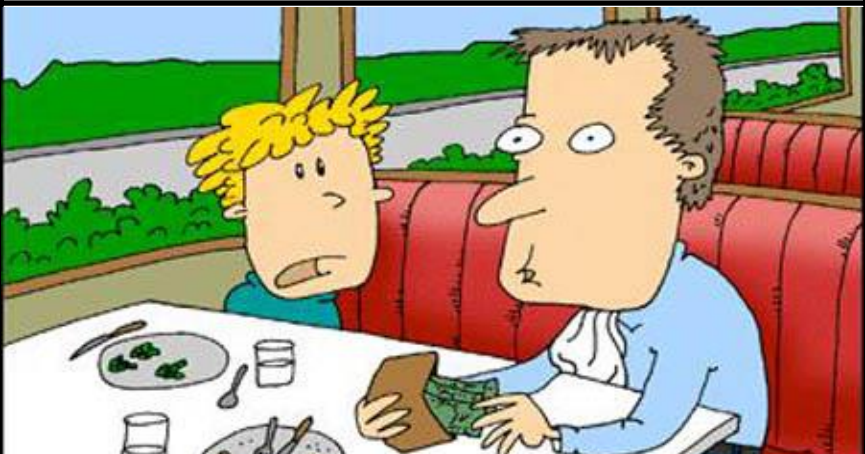
**ACNA Provincial Liturgy
