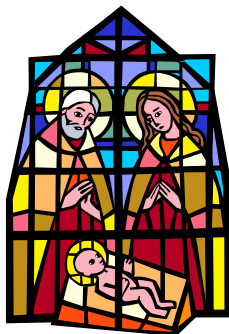
Christmas Lessons and Carols & Family Feast
