Holy Baptism/Confirmation/ Re-Affirmation/Reception

Several people have expressed interest in either Holy Baptism, Confirmation, Re-Affirmation and/or Reception.



Holy Baptism is for those not yet baptized with water in the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit - both adults and children.

Confirmation is for those who have already been baptized and who are ready to make a public profession of the journey of faith.

Re-Affirmation is for adults who have already been both baptized and confirmed but who want to receive the laying-on-of hands for the continued strengthening of the Holy Spirit.

Reception is for those who wish to be received into the fellowship of the Anglican church who have been baptized and were confirmed by a bishop in another of the Christian traditions.
