



ANNOUNCING ALPHA 2017

For several years Father Darrell and our prayer team have been praying that we would have an opportunity to do Alpha as a parish. Until recently this was impossible simply because the physical space was not available.



However, our growing relationship with Solid Rock Wesleyan Church has provided us an opportunity to share Alpha together with that congregation.

We are very please this morning to announce that we will run Alpha this winter semester.

PARRAMOS

Saint Gabriel House

FAMILY: Yancos Ichaj

They are a humble and respectful family, Mr. Luis Yancos of 47 years olds works on agriculture to carry the daily sustenance to his family, Ms. Josefina Ichaj of 49 years old does the house work, the family has 8 children, the first 4 are married, and the unmarried children are, Lesly of 15 years old who helps with the trades of the home, Alex of 13 years old helps the father in agriculture, Gabriela of 10 years studies in 5th grade at AOJ, Julio who is 7 years old studies in 1st grade, the family lives in a House made of blades and cane, pieces of wood, cook with firewood, have water services, electric light, and bathroom service.

Philip Tucker House

Donated in his memory by the “Sissy Girls”

FAMILY: Sánchez Pablo

It is a family that struggles to move forward because of the economic difficulties. Mr. Carlos Sánchez of 26 years works on agriculture to support his family, Ms. Tirsa Pablo of 26 years takes care of the house and takes care of their 3 children, Estuardo who is 8 years is studying in 2nd grade, Alex of 6 years, Yoselin of 3, the family lives in a house made of old blade sheets, they live in a small room, the kitchen only has a blade sheet ceiling, they cook with firewood, they do not have electricity and water.

ITZAPA

St Stephen the Martyr House:

Donated by Church of the Good Samaritan in honour of
St Stephen the Martyr

FAMILY: Velasquez Azurdia.

It is a family that lives humbly, Mr. Augusto Velasquez of 50 years old does several trades to bring sustenance to his family; there are days that there is lack of work, for such reason they cannot make improvements to their house, Ms. María Magdalena Azurdia of 39 years works in agricultural wages, takes care of their 4 children, Luis who is 12 years old and studies in 5th grade, Lesly who is 10 years old and studies in 4th grade, Josue who is 7 years old and studies in 1st grade, Dylan who is 2 year old. The family lives in a House made of damaged blade sheets and adobe (landslides). The family has washable bathroom service, electric light and water.

Camp House

Donated by Bruce and Renee Noseworthy in memory of
Renee's Mom.

FAMILY: Coj Velásquez.

The family struggles to move forward. The little economic income does not allow them to make improvements in the house. Mr. Wilfredo Coj who is 34 years old does several jobs to earn the support of his family, Ms. María Andrea Velásquez of 34 years old performs the duties of the house and takes care of their 5 children, Carlos of 14 studies in 2nd grade, Jorge of 11 studies in 3rd grade, Ingrid of 8 is in 1st grade, Mynor of 4 and Lincy of 10 months, the family's home is made of blade sheets and in the same room they have the kitchen. A family member donated 30 concrete blocks and are placed low side of the house, they have bathroom service, electric light and water.

EL TEJAR

John Christopher Kennedy House

FAMILY: Simon of Peace

The family lives humbly because of the low economic income and has not allowed them to make improvements to their house. Mr.

Cecilio Simón of 40 years old is a pilot, 2 years ago he was diagnosed with diabetes and can no longer work as a pilot, Ms. Claudia Paz of 26 years does the house work and takes care of their 3 children, Alexander of 14 studies in 7th grade, Joselin of 10 studies in 4th grade, Juliana of 7 studies in 1st grade, the family house is made of blades, nylon and pieces of cardboard. They have 2 small rooms, the kitchen only has blade ceiling, and it is leaning against the Block wall of the neighborhood family. They have water and electricity services; they are provided by the neighbor. They also have bathroom services.

Samuel Piercey House

Donated in his memory by his wife Shirley

FAMILY: Chuy Choc.

The Family struggles to move forward, Mr. Cristóbal Chuy of 34 years, works as a farmer to provide for the family expenses, Mrs. Obdulia Choc of 33 years does the house work and takes care of her 6 children, Jorge who is 11 years and studies in 4th grade, Jackeline who is 9 and studies in 2nd grade, Wilder who is 6 is in Kindergarten, Isabel is 4, Heidy with 2 months old, the family lives in a small room made of Wood pieces and it is heavily damaged and the wooden boards are very damaged, the kitchen is made of sheet and damaged wood. They have water services. The electricity and bathroom services are provided by a family member.
