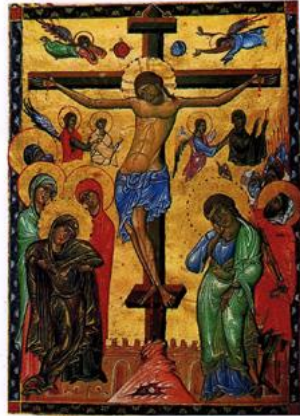

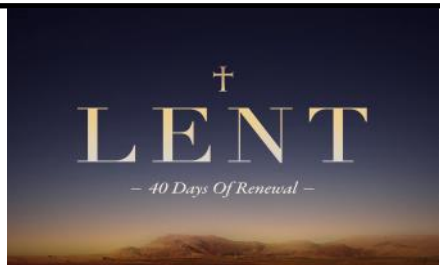
We are asking that you contribute these items over the next four weeks.
