Doctor of Ministry Project

Raising Up, Equipping, and Sustaining Christian Foster Families

As most people are aware, Father Darrell is working on a doctor of ministry degree, the focus of which is raising, equipping, and sustaining Christian foster families. As part of his study, he plans to hold four evening discussion groups. These gatherings are for Christian families, and will involve a presentation and open discussion. While the focus of the research is on foster care, this work is equally applicable to Christian families in general.
