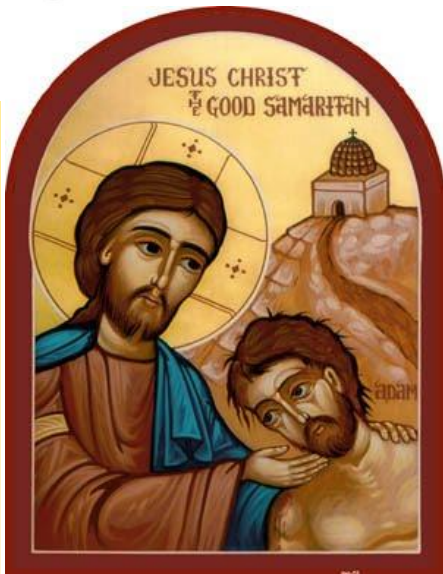

Doctor of Ministry Project

Raising Up, Equipping, and Sustaining Christian Foster Families
