I will no longer lead the rector's Bible Study on Thursday afternoons. Instead, I will lead a Bible Study for leaders 9-10AM Sunday mornings. Those leaders will, in turn, (at some convenient place and time throughout the week) offer the same Bible Study for others.

Everyone will look at the same passage, and leaders will have been equipped to lead because they will already have studied the passage with me and the other leaders. I am very grateful for Susan Squires, John Dinn+, Pearleen Kennedy, Marilyn Flower+, and Polycarp Erivwo who have agreed to lead midweek Bible Studies. If you are willing to be a Bible Study leader please speak with me as soon as possible. These Bible studies will begin the week of Sunday, Sept. 17, and continue for ten weeks. Next Sunday I hope to have the schedule set for when and where each study will meet.

This is the cell model of church growth and has been proven to be very successful in many other places. This model of Bible Study will raise up and equip new leaders.
