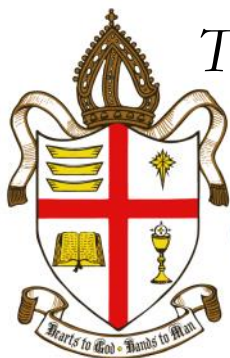

PARISH COUNCIL

Parish Council Report

The parish council met on Thursday evening and had a very productive meeting.

Our total year-to-date income is \$104,589.58 just under the \$106,000.00 budgeted.

Our year-to-date expenses are \$98,827.58, significantly under our budgeted of \$105,904.00.

We have, therefore, a present surplus of \$5,762.00.

So far this year \$15,301.36 has been added to the building fund. The total building fund is now \$279,186.50.

Council also discussed the recent meeting with ++Currie, and our new Bible Study plan. Council expressed its gratitude to +Harvey and Marilyn+.
